- Must have a High School Diploma or GED, or currently enrolled in an Adult High School Diploma or GED class; complete a CASAS Assessment; and pass a drug screening.

In the Business Management Pathway, participants will learn goal setting resource allocation, organizational structure and management techniques. This unique course is a partnership between Bakersfield Adult School, BARC, County of Kern, and Kern Alliance of Business.
