# NURSE ASSISTANT & HOME HEALTH AIDE



The <u>Nurse Assistant Training Program</u>
(NATP) prepares the student to provide health care services and the role of:



- Caregivers
- Healthcare environment
- Healthcare safety
- · Adult needs in health & illness
- Basic care giving skills

Upon successful completion of the <u>NATP</u>, students are eligible to take the competency exam as a <u>CNA</u>

Course can range from <u>8-16 Weeks</u>, depending on the semester and classes chosen

The <u>Home Health Aide (HHA) Program</u> is a (40-Hour) training that expands on the content taught during <u>NATP</u>

- MUST have a current CNA Certificate
- The program consists of (20-hours) of theory and up to (27-hours) of clinical work
- It is designed to train CNAs in the basic concept of home healthcare by providing the skills and knowledge to competently meet the needs of clients in their home

All students must complete a certified background check before participating in the program These programs are only open to individuals who have completed the prerequisites and have been accepted into the program by BC Allied Health Program.
