KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

The job is production line work. If you are hired, you will be working in very wet, cold and humid conditions. You will be required to stand during your entire shift. The job involves constantly working with your hands, twisting your body from side to side and repetitive bodily motions to move the product down the line. Most employees are rotated to perform duties throughout the plant; you must be willing to work in various areas. You will need to work very closely with others and to work as part of a team. At times, you will be required to repetitively lift heavy objects, usually 10-55 lbs. at a time. You will also be required to learn, understand, and follow safety rules and requirements. You must be able to work very quickly in order to meet production deadlines.

WAGE

The starting wage for the position is \$12.50 per hour. All hours worked over eight (8) straight-time hours in a day and (40) in a week are paid at the overtime rate of time and a half (\$18.75). Employees are paid every other week.

SHIFT LENGTH

If you are hired, there will be times when you will be required to work very long hours – up to (14-16) hours in a day – up to (6) or (7) days per week. On other days, you may be working only a few hours, maybe even NO hours at all. Copper River Seafoods does not guarantee the number of hours that you will work. It depends on the amount of seafood there is to process.

HOUSING / MEALS / LAUNDRY SERVICE

Housing, meals and laundry service are available in all plants (except in Anchorage) at the rate of \$15.00 per day. Half of the amount charged will be reimbursed at the end of season if you complete the season in good standing. Employees are usually housed two, three or more per room. Your personal space is very limited, and you must be able to get along with other people.
