Certificate Program

EMT training will teach students how to provide quick medical treatment in cases of illness and trauma. EMT training requires a good physical condition and extensive preparation, since EMTs work under dangerous and adverse conditions.

Prerequisites

- 18 years or older
- CPR Card - Option to take course during the first two weeks of class at a reduced rate
- Completed Livescan Background Check
This requirement is not in place until Spring 2024
- Immunization Records
See list of required Taft College vaccinations
- Uniforms (Items can be purchased at Walmart)
White crew neck t-shirt, white polo shirt, blue or black non-denim pants, black belt, black shoes or boots, and a watch. This is covered in the first day of class and have two weeks to obtain
